Please make sure your e-mail address is legible as we send out confirmations, show instructions, and results via e-mail. If you have changed your e-mail, mailing address, phone number, or any other information, please highlight this information for us when you submit your entry.

**We utilize the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination. We will send out electronic confirmations and electronic results after the trial. Please make sure your e-mail address on your entry form is legible.**

### **DAILY FEES AND PACKAGE RATES:**

- Each individual run: \$10
- Full weekend package (all 16 runs): First Dog: \$140, Additional Dogs: \$130 each
- Saturday & Sunday Runs (all 12 runs): First Dog: \$100, Additional Dogs: \$90 each
- Eight runs for the weekend per dog: \$70
- Junior Handlers: \$5 a run for all classes
- Day of Show Entry for Friday: \$12.00 Per Class
- Day of Show Entry for Saturday and/or Sunday: \$12.00 Per Class

Please note – there are no Package's available for Day of Show Entries

### **DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES:**

Friday Classes: Day of show entries will be accepted until 1:45 PM with a cost of \$12 a run. Please note; if you arrive at 1:45 PM there will be a good possibility that one of the classes may already be completed.

Saturday & Sunday: We will accept day of show entries for Saturday and/or Sunday provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$12 a run with no package deals. Day of show entries will only be accepted during check-in and must be completed before the morning General Briefing. It is recommended that you e-mail [izziew@wappraisal.com](mailto:izziew@wappraisal.com) the week before the trial to see if we have room for Day of Show Entries.

**REMEMBER: Any printed running order is always very tentative.** We will do our best to separate dogs run by the same handler in the same class.

**ENTRY CHANGES:** The trial closing date is June 5, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. **We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.** Accepted entries may be changed prior to June 5, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. E-mail change requests to [izziew@wappraisal.com](mailto:izziew@wappraisal.com) or by calling 719-252-1009 (NOTE: e-mail is highly preferred). **No changes will be made at the trial, so please read your confirmations carefully.**

**REFUNDS:** There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date with a \$10 processing fee per dog. Refunds after the closing date will be honored only for bitches in season with a \$10.00 per dog processing fee assessed. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, snow, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

**BAD CHECKS:** Any person who writes a check for “insufficient funds” and/or otherwise a “bad check” will not be allowed to participate in this event until a money order or cashier’s check for the amount of the original check; plus \$40.00 is received.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups between days will be permitted at this trial.

#### **TENTATIVE START TIME:**

Friday: Check in at 1:15 pm and walk through at 1:45 pm. Runs will begin no earlier than 2:00 PM.

Saturday & Sunday: 7:30 am Check-in and 7:45am Walk Through times, First dog on line at 8:00am

Please do not arrive at the trial site before 6:30 AM **Day of Show entries will be taken during check-in.**

**E-MAIL:** E-mails sent to [izziew@wappraisal.com](mailto:izziew@wappraisal.com) regarding trial 'stuff' will be responded to within 4 days (usually within one day on weekdays). Funny things happen in cyberspace; e-mails get lost, e-mail addresses cannot be read, spam filters, etc., so if you send an e-mail and do not get a response within 4 days, please e-mail again. If you entered the trial but did not get a confirmation, please e-mail. Don't worry about 'bugging' the Trial Secretary. Please read over your confirmations carefully. We all make errors and we will certainly make corrections as long as we are notified prior to the closing date as that is when the catalog and running orders are printed.

**AWARDS:** First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all categories, levels, and classes (except Chances which has no placements). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for any qualifying score.

#### **DOG REGISTRATION NUMBERS**

You will need to register your dog(s) with NADAC. Dogs can be registered on-line at the NADAC web site at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) (click on “Dogs” on the Home Page and then on “Dog Reg. Form”).

#### **EQUIPMENT**

All equipment will meet NADAC specifications and will include an A-Frame, Dog Walk, Tunnels, Hoops, Weave Poles with 24” spacing, Winged and Non-Winged Jumps. Electronic timers will also be used.

#### **VETERAN DOG RULE**

**As of January 2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday.**

**Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday.**

#### **ENTRY RULES**

We will accept entries starting April 24, 2017, up until the run limit has been reached, or until the Closing Date occurs. Incomplete or inaccurate forms will NOT be accepted. No hand deliveries please. Do NOT send an entry that requires a signature. If you use express mail, check the box “Signature Waived”. Entries received earlier than Opening Date will be returned unopened.

#### **NADAC TREATS RULE**

NADAC allows handler to carry treats during a run, if the treats are secured in a sealed container that is not visible to the dog, the judge, or other exhibitors. If a container or a sealed bag falls out during a run, it is not

grounds for elimination unless the judge of record believes there is unethical behavior involved. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring.

**SITE INFORMATION: Fox Run Regional Park, 2110 Stella Dr., Colorado Springs, CO, 80921**

- Ring surface is outdoors on grass. Please help us in keeping the site clean and as we found it before arriving with lots of dogs.
- NOTE! No tents with bottoms or tarps are allowed. However, breathable dog mats are allowed.
- The sprinklers are to be turned off for the show, but beware they might come on.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates, and at their motel.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES.
- Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited.
- NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.
- Parents are solely responsible for their children, and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.

**\*\*NOTE: ALL trash, food, dog treats, etc. MUST be removed every night, due to the possibility of bears in the area at night!!**

**RV PARKING**

## NADAC RULES AND REGULATIONS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. By entering this trial, the exhibitor is representing that he/she is knowledgeable of NADAC's rules. Exhibitors Handbooks are available free of charge by downloading from NADAC's web site at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com).

### SKILLED AND PROFICIENT CATEGORIES

**A dog may be entered in one category, Skilled or Proficient, per weekend.** A dog may not be entered in Skilled one day and Proficient on another day. Dogs may enter the Skilled or Proficient category in the Standard, Veteran, or Junior Handler Division.

**Note: When entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires.**

Dogs are allotted the standard course time for, and are scored and placed in the jump height entered.

Dogs may have up to five course, or time faults, and still receive a 5 point qualifier toward their Regular Agility title. All other classes require that you have a clean run, with no course, or time faults, to earn a Q.

### VETERAN/DISABLED HANDLER

Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requirement. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

#### **Dogs which require measuring:**

Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

#### **Dogs which do not need to be measured:**

Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division

Dogs jumping 20"

Dogs in the Skilled Category

Dogs with a permanent height card

Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

### JUMP HEIGHTS

There are five Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Please see the NADAC Rulebook for the full jump height table.

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

**As of January-2014:** Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday..

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to <http://www.NADACForum.com> and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and in forming NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS.** Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- **No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.**
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
