ENTRY INFORMATION: PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS OVER CAREFULLY. NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE AT THE TRIAL.

Our Microsoft Word entry form allows you to type in your information. Please use this option as it makes it so much easier to read entry information. Please make sure your e-mail address is legible as we send out confirmations, show instructions, and results via e-mail. If you have changed your e-mail, mailing address, phone number, or any other information, please highlight this information for us when you submit your entry.

We utilize the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination. We will send out electronic confirmations and electronic results after the trial. Please make sure your e-mail address on your entry form is legible.

DAILY FEES AND PACKAGE RATES:

- Each individual run: \$9
- Full weekend package (all 14 runs): First Dog: \$110, Additional Dogs: \$105 each
- Saturday & Sunday Runs (all 11 runs): First Dog: \$90, Additional Dogs: \$85 each
- Eight runs for the weekend: \$70
- Junior Handlers: \$5 a run for all classes
- Day of Show Entry for Friday: \$10.00 Per Class
- Day of Show Entry for Saturday and/or Sunday: \$10.00 Per Class

Please note – there are no Package's available for Day of Show Entries

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES:

Friday Classes: Day of show entries will be accepted until 2:45 PM with a cost of \$10 a run. Please note; if you arrive at 2:45 PM there will be a good possibility that one of the classes may already be completed.

Saturday & Sunday: We will accept day of show entries for Saturday and/or Sunday provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$10 a run with no package deals. Day of show entries will only be accepted during check-in and must be completed before the morning General Briefing. It is recommended that you e-mail izziew@wappraisal.com the week before the trial to see if we have room for Day of Show Entries.

REMEMBER: Any printed running order is always very tentative. We will do our best to separate dogs run by the same handler in the same class.

ENTRY DATA: Entries with postmarks BEFORE Dec. 29, 2009 will not be accepted. The entry postmark date will be the determining factor for entry acceptance order. There is no need to overnight entries. The trial closing date is Jan. 22, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. **We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.**

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after the closing date will be honored only for bitches in season. A \$10.00 processing fee per dog will be assessed for ANY refund. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

Accepted entries may be changed prior to Jan. 22, 2010 at 9:00 p.m. E-mail change requests to izziew@wappraisal.com or by calling 719-252-1009 (NOTE: e-mail is highly preferred). No changes will be made at the trial, so please read your confirmations carefully. If you have questions, e-mail.

E-mail confirmations will be sent; Please read over your confirmations carefully. We all make errors and we will certainly make corrections as long as we are notified prior to the closing date as that is when scribe sheets and running orders are printed. If by chance you entered and did not get an e-mail, please e-mail me to check.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com

Any person who writes a check for “insufficient funds” and/or otherwise a “bad check” will not be allowed to participate in this event until a money order or cashier’s check for the amount of the original check; plus \$40.00 returned check fee is received.

VETERAN HANDLER: Handlers aged 60 years or older or disabled handlers may opt to enter Touch N Go, Tunnelers, and/or Weavers as a Veteran Handler which allows you to receive 10% more standard course time. This division is for Veteran Handlers only. If entered as a VH all classes are veterans for all dogs entered by that handler.

SITE INFORMATION:

The Trial will be indoors on dirt. Parking is fairly close to the ring. **This facility’s crating space will be at a premium. Please be considerate and efficient with your setup (stacked crates, X Pens with multiple dogs only, etc.) The show committee reserves the right to limit crating space as needed.**

COMMUNICATING WITH TRIAL SECRETARY:

E-mails sent to izziew@wappraisal.com regarding trial 'stuff' will be responded to within 4 days (usually within one day on weekdays). Funny things happen in cyberspace; e-mails get lost, e-mail addresses cannot be read, spam filters, etc., so if you send an e-mail and do not get a response within 4 days, please e-mail again. If you entered the trial but did not get a confirmation, please e-mail. Don't worry about 'bugging' the Trial Secretary. Please read over your confirmations carefully. AWARDS: First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all categories, levels, and classes (except Chances which has no placements). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for any qualifying score.

IMPORTANT! Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

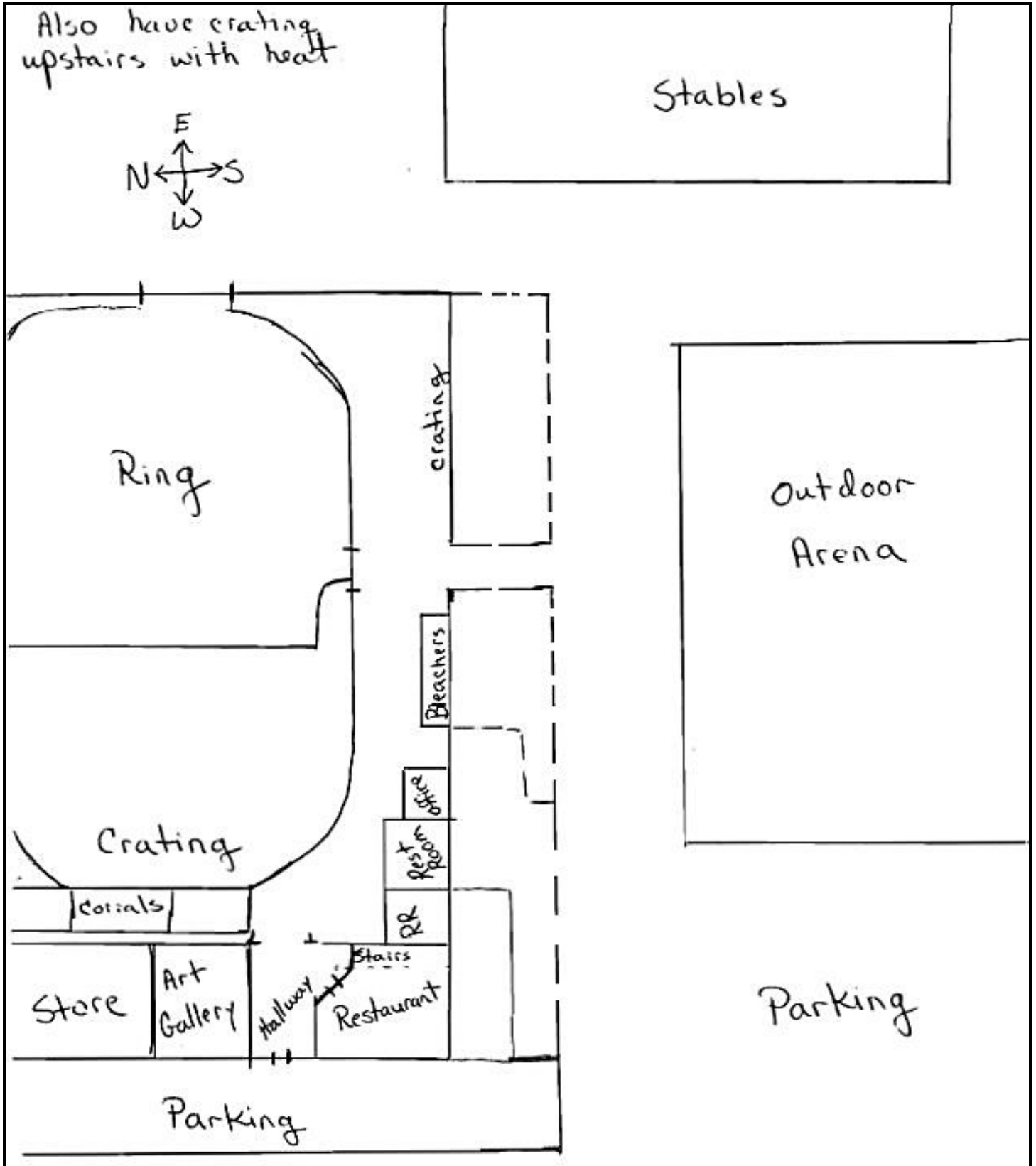
DIRECTIONS:

From Colo. Springs: Take Hwy 83 North to Hodgen Rd. Go east to Meridian Rd. Then south on Meridian to Latigo, take Latigo east to the 2nd Halleluaiah Trail entrance, turn left, the Equestrian Center will be on the right.

Or, take Woodmen east to Meridian. Go north on Meridian approx. 5 miles to Latigo Blvd. Go east on Latigo to 2nd Halleluaiah Trail entrance, turn left, the Equestrian Center will be on the right.

From I-25, North(Denver): Get off at Monument Exit and head east on CR105 to SR83, go right and go south 2.7 mi to Hodgen Rd. Turn left on Hodgen and go east 8.6 mi to Meridian, Turn right on Meridian and go south 4.9 mi to Latigo Blvd. Left on Latigo and go east 1.4 mi to the 2nd Halleluaiah Trail entrance, turn left, the Equestrian Center will be on the right.
